Phase 2 COVID-19 Requirements and Procedures

Effective June 1, 2020

1. Before opening the studio for the day, the owner will take his/her temperature and make sure surfaces have been sanitized since last use.
2. All clients and the owner are required to wear masks while in the studio. Cloth masks will be provided to clients without them. On leaving the studio for the final time that day, borrowed masks are to be left in a mask return container for laundering and sanitizing by the owner.
3. On entering to use the studio for the first time, clients are required to go to reception to sign a waiver which includes a short safety review by the owner of both COVID 19 measures and operation of the equipment. Clients are encouraged but not required to provide one form of contact information at that time, which will be held as confidential information. A separate mailing list sign-up will also be available for those who wish to hear about special events or offers.
Subsequent entries to use the studio will only require the client to log in.
All clients will be reminded that if they are not feeling well or have other COVID-19 symptoms they should not enter the studio.
4. Owner and Clients are required to wash hands for 20 seconds before entering the main studio. Hand sanitizer will also be available but washing hands for 20 seconds is preferred. Gloves will be provided and recommended when using tools as long as the gloves don't interfere with safe operation of the tool or machine.
5. During phase 2 a maximum of 3 clients (of different households) at a time will be allowed in the studio. All sewing stations are 6' apart but with only 3 clients greater separation will be possible. Clients will need to take turns using the iron and cutting table in order to keep the 6' social distance. A movable, auxiliary table can also be placed 6' from sewing/ironing stations and used for cutting if needed.
6. Sanitizing wipes and/or gloves will be available to wipe down shared equipment after each use.
7. Once a client is done using the studio, all surfaces he/she has touched will be sanitized before use by another client.
8. During phase 2 food will not be allowed in the studio and drinks will not be provided by the owner. Clients can bring their own bottles (refillable preferred) and can fill them in the restroom.
9. The restroom will be sanitized daily before opening and surfaces wiped down with sanitizer after each use.
10. Clients who are at elevated risk of contracting COVID-19 due to age or other illness can request to use the studio during normal closed hours where only they and the owner will be present. A 2 hour minimum will be charged for off-hour use.
